

**THERE ARE TIMES** when everything seems to break down at once. That is how it seems in Israel as we receive multiple requests for help from one end of the country to the other. The 18+ months of pandemic have stretched the finances of many towns, institutions and families to a breaking point. I am convinced that God has a heart to help each of them and that Bridges for Peace is acting as His hands and feet reaching out with love to encourage and meet practical needs. Let me share some of those needs.

#### **Bomb Shelters**

In the aftermath of the recent conflict in which Gaza fired over 4,000 rockets toward Israel, two towns have come to us asking for help to build bomb shelters. In fact, many communities are underprepared and need assistance. To provide protection for Israeli families, donate to our Crisis Assistance Fund.



#### **Bnei Menashe**

The spread of the pandemic in India has placed the remaining members of the Bnei Menashe (Sons of Manasseh—one of the 12 tribes) community at increased risk. Many have lost their jobs, and hunger is a new problem. The next group is scheduled to arrive in Israel in October. Between now and then, they need food. We are partnering with Rabbi Michael Freund and Shavei Israel (Return Israel) to bring them home, welcome them and provide 100-pound (45-kg) bags of rice to those who are waiting to come. Since only 250 come at a time, many families will need food assistance for the foreseeable future. Donate to our New Immigrant Fund to help these families.

## Rosh HaShanah (Jewish New Year)

The fall holiday season is in September. For many years we have tried to give extra during this time, as we know the costs of entertaining and buying specialty foods are high. Our team is working now to prepare special holiday food packages for thousands of needy Israelis, including Holocaust survivors, children, widows and new immigrants. This is in addition to the regular food supplies given to over 22,000 each month. To help put food on the table, please give to our Food Project.

### **Relief from the Summer Heat**

This summer has been very hot. We received a call for assistance from the town of Beit Shean—home to amazing

ancient ruins and also one of the hottest towns in Israel. Their request? Fans for needy immigrants, including many of the Bnei Menashe. I am happy to tell you that 200 fans are on the way as I write. To provide relief from the scorching summer heat, please donate to our Immigrant Welcome Gifts fund.
